**Synopsis** 

The program Wartawan Muda is an experiential learning program aimed at developing and giving the students a higher understanding and appreciation of the Malay language through journalism. It is a dynamic program which activates the imagination, develops confidence and explores language from the written and spoken words.

Overview

: A unique program that combines experiential learning and the art of communication. During the session, the students will be introduced to the exciting world of journalism. Focus will be on the basics of journalism, such as interviewing and writing about the news - the who, what, when, where and why of writing a story. Using specially selected Apps, students will have the opportunity to watch and assess their how well they have done when making "live" reporting.

  - 3. To have a strong interest in Malay language.

  - 2. To learn the effectiveness of using attention grabbing headlines, captivating introduction, proper structuring for the news story.
  - 3. To help students develop confidence when conveying ideas in written communication.
